

# What is Medicare?

Medicare is health insurance for most people 65 and older or people with disabilities. It's government subsidized and broken down into four different parts listed below.



## Part A

- ✓ Hospital care
- ✓ Hospice
- ✓ At-home nursing
- ✓ Skilled nursing facility care

## Part B

- ✓ Doctor's office visits
- ✓ Preventative care services
- ✓ Medical items (diabetes testing supplies, nebulizers, home medical equipment)
- ✓ Mental health services
- ✓ Skilled nursing facility care

## Part C

- ✓ All part A & B (except hospice)
- ✓ Vision, dental, & hearing
- ✓ Non-medically necessary services
- ✓ Medical savings account plans
- ✓ Most include prescription coverage

## Part D

- ✓ Prescriptions
